1. Grading

I do **NOT** do a ton of worksheets, so don't expect work to come home with your child.

Your child has 15 minutes daily in homeroom to complete homework, so they may not have work to do often. Please do not stay on IXL for longer than 30 minutes on a skill.

Daily In Class work

- Materials ready
- Positive attitude
- Tries all assigned problems
- Collaborates
- Appropriate Behavior

5 pts/day

IXL Homework

- Graded out of 10 (90% = 9/10)
 - OR 30 min practice = 100%
- Always due following MONDAY
 @ 8am
 - Late IXL is <u>NOT</u> accepted
 - Usually 2 per skills week

20 pts/wk

Tests

- Calculation Based w/ some multiple choice
- I am open to making up points if the student fails
- Study: Practice assigned skills on IXL
